Skype is capable of making high definition video calls. HD calling has clear video quality, synchronous audio, and an experience almost as if you were sitting in front of someone else. However, full-HD Skype calls have some technical requirements. You need a smartphone or a fast computer, a high definition camera, and a high-speed network with enough bandwidth (at least 1.5 Mbps). Other Skype callers can't take advantage of your HD calls unless they have high-speed network connections, high-definition cameras, and the latest equipment. The instructions in this article apply to Skype version 4.1 and above for mobile devices and version 7.0 and higher for Macs and PCs. After you determine that your setup meets the requirements above, you can start an HD call from the Skype app or by using Skype online. In the Skype app, click the Call button in the upper-left corner. Depending on your version of Skype, this button might be named Call. From the contact list, find the contact you want to invite to the call. Select the Video button to the right of the contact to start a video call instantly. Follow these steps to make a video call from the Skype website: Go to the Skype website and sign in using the button in the upper right corner. Click the Call button.
